- 1. The Department of Education through DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2018, titled, "Policy Guidelines on the Administration of the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory" shall continue to administer the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) assessment.
- 2. In reference to DM-CT-2024-447, Phil-IRI shall be administered to Key Stage 2 (Grade 4 to 6) and Key Stage 3 (Grade 7 to 10) learners in public elementary and secondary schools nationwide to measure and describe the learners' reading performance in both English and Filipino languages in oral reading, silent reading and listening comprehension.



- 4. The materials for Phil-IRI assessment can be accessed through this link: https://tinyurl.com/DapPhil-IRIMaterials. The procedure stipulated in the Phil-IRI Manual for key stage 2 and 3 shall be followed.
- 5. Schools shall be provided with supplies for the printing of Phil-IRI Assessment Tools, charged against downloaded funds to the division office for the Printing of Phil-IRI Assessment Tools for Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3 subject to the usual accounting and auditing guidelines.
- 6. The school head/school reading coordinator shall consolidate the data (BOSY and EOSY) which includes the results of the Group Screening Test (GST) and individualized Assessment, and the data shall be uploaded in the Phil-IRI School Submission Form through this link:
