

REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP OF SCHOOL HEADS AND GRADE ONE TEACHERS ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE MULTI-FACTORED ASSESSMENT TOOL (MFAT)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

This Region

- In alignment with the Department of Education's thrust to promote inclusive and equitable quality education, the administration of Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT) is one of the key strategies to support learners with diverse learning needs at the primary level. However, its successful implementation depends on the capacity of teachers and school leaders to understand its components and to use the tool with fidelity and consistency.
- This regional training is designed to provide a hands-on and in-depth orientation on the MFAT, including its theoretical foundation, administration procedures, scoring and interpretation, and how to utilize results for instructional planning. The training workshop is on September 19-21, 2025, at Zamboanga del Sur. Specific venue will be announced in a separate issuance after the BAC procedure.
- The training aims to: 3.
 - 1. Familiarize participants with the structure, components, and purpose of the Multi-Factored Assessment Tool.
 - 2. Equip Grade One teachers with the necessary skills in administering the MFAT with validity and reliability.
 - 3. Enable school heads to provide instructional supervision and support to teachers in the implementation of MFAT.
 - 4. Guide participants in interpreting assessment data and using it to inform instructional planning and learner support.


